

Southwest Minnesota Regional Advisory Committee

Recommendation for PSIC Grant Subscriber Equipment Funding Allocation

Date: April 1, 2009

Funding Available: \$518,613 plus a (20%) local match of \$129,653 for a total of \$648,266

The Southwest Minnesota Regional Advisory Committee recommends to the Southwest Minnesota Regional Radio Board an initial allocation of the PSIC subscriber equipment Grant funds for the Southwest Region in equal shares among the parties to the Board.

Each member receiving PSIC Grant funding for the purchase of 700/800 MHz subscriber equipment must meet the following requirements:

1. Not later than August 15, 2009 certify to the Chair of the SW Minnesota Regional Radio Board that sufficient funds are (or will be) available to meet the local grant match requirement. The following are appropriate sources for local match funding:
 - a. Properly budgeted funds provided in the 2009 operating budget.
 - b. Funds provided in the 2010 operating budget and available for use by January 1, 2010. This should require a binding commitment to provide the funding by the governing body of the participating member.
 - c. Funds properly budgeted by local jurisdictions for 2009 or committed for the 2010 budget year and available for use by January 1, 2010 (Cities, townships, school districts, etc.).
 - d. Funds from Tribal governments or qualified NGO's participating in the program.
2. Each participating member may choose to use their full initial allocation or a part thereof. The August 15, 2009 letter certifying availability of matching funds should also include the level of participation desired by the participating member.
3. Each respective member receiving PSIC Grant Funds should seek the participation of tribal governments and qualified Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO's) located within or providing services within their jurisdictions in the development of expenditure plans.
4. All allocations not matched by August 15, 2009 will be available for re-allocation to participating members by the SW Minnesota Regional Radio Board. It is the recommendation of the RAC that the Board designate September 16, 2009 as the date for re-allocation of non-committed PSIC Grant Funds. Re-allocation of grant funds will require compliance with all grant match requirements.

The individual allocations and required match amounts are contained in the following table.
